HEALTH CLAIM GUIDE

Availing of the Services

Visit any of the network or outside hospitals. If you opt for a network hospital you are eligible to get the benefit of 'Cashless Services' while in case of a non-network hospital, you have to settle the bill and claim reimbursement from us.

Claim Procedure

I. Hospitalisation in Network Hospitals (Definition explained later in this booklet) - Cashless

Lodging a claim for reimbursement

Within 21 days after discharge, please lodge your claim with the TPA for processing your claim. Send the filled and signed Claim Form. You can download the Claim Form from our or TPA's website www.paramounttpa.com/aegonlife. When lodging your claim with the TPA, please make sure that all the documents listed below are submitted.

1. Claim form duly filled in bearing the signature of the Policyholder & attested by the hospital wherever requested
2. Photocopy of the Aegon Life Health ID card or Current Policy
3. Photocopy of photo ID proof. (Refer to the list of Photo IDs accepted by TPA below)
4. Attested Photocopies (from treating hospital) of Discharge Card / Summary
5. Attested Photocopies (from treating hospital) of the final hospital bill with detailed break up of charges
6. If Package Treatment, break up of details of package bill
7. Medico Legal Certificate (MLC) in accidental case
8. Photocopies of all investigations done with the respective bills & reports
9. Photocopies of all bills for medicines supported by relevant prescriptions

Note : TPA or the Company reserves the right to demand any other document(s), information from the Policyholder

List of documents accepted for Photo ID:

- Voter's ID card
- PAN card
- Passport
- Driving License
- ID issued by Employer / College / School
- Debit/ Credit Photo card

Key Definitions

Cashless Service

With our cashless service, you don't have to pay hospitalisation expenses or the hospital bills at the end of treatment / discharge except for expenses insured beyond the cashless authorization and/or beyond the T&C of the policy. This facility is available only at the network hospitals. The network hospital will coordinate the authorisation for cashless services with the TPA on your behalf.

The authorisation along with a copy of the Health ID card issued by us and Photo ID (Refer to the list of Photo IDs accepted by TPA) has to be given to the network hospital at the time of admission. The cashless access at the network hospital is merely a facility extended to the insured and does not guarantee the availability, quality and outcome of the treatment.

Choosing of a network or a non-network hospital is the prerogative of the Policyholder / insured.

Note: Cashless Service/ Authorisation is subject to Policy Holder complying all the requirements for availing such service. The TPA may deny cashless authorisation.

Third Party Administrator (TPA)

TPA shall mean a Third Party Administrator who is licensed by the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority (IRDAI) and is engaged, for providing assistance in claims under the policy.

Network Hospitals

Network providers are hospitals and nursing homes who have contracted with TPA to provide cashless service for inpatient treatment, for ailments, diseases and medical conditions covered under the Plan, to all those who are insured. The list of network hospitals is provided in a booklet along with the policy document. Please note that the TPA adds or deletes network hospitals regularly; hence to get the most recent list of network hospitals, please call the TPA toll free line at 1800-22-6655 or log on to their website <http://www.paramounttpa.com/aegonlife>

Cashless Authorisation

It means a authorisation by the TPA for a cashless service to the Network Hospitals for the benefits under the Policy.

Intimation

A communication in the prescribed form by the Policyholder or his/her representatives to the TPA appointed by us for a prospective claim or treatment mentioning the details of treatment, estimated costs, place of treatment date and duration of treatment.

In case of planned hospitalization, intimation has to be made atleast 48 hours prior to the admission. In case of emergency hospitalization, intimation has to be within 24 hours of such hospitalization. Intimation is mandatory for both cashless as well as reimbursement claims.

Reimbursement Claim

For all types of claims where the Policy Holder has paid for treatments especially at non-network hospitals and has not availed the cashless service at the network hospital, the Policy Holder can claim for reimbursement of the eligible expenses up to the limit of the plan and within the terms and conditions of the policy. In case of planned hospitalisation, the policyholder is required to intimate the TPA 48 hours prior to the hospitalisation. In case of emergency hospitalisation, intimation has to be within 24 hours of such hospitalisation.

Please Note: The TPA will authorise "Cashless Service" but it may be denied in the following circumstances e.g.

- In case of any ambiguity in the coverage of the present ailment with respect to the policy terms and conditions based on the documents / information sent to the TPA or Aegon Life Insurance.
- Any false, manipulated or forged documents and information presented to the TPA.
- The ailment / condition etc. not being covered under the Health plan.
- The insured amount not being sufficient to cover the hospitalisation expenses.
- If the request for preauthorisation is not received by the TPA in time.
- If the information / documents sent to the TPA is insufficient to confirm coverage.
- Any other reason which will be communicated to you in the denial letter.

Denial of “Cashless Service” is not denial of treatment. The Policy Holder can continue with the treatment, pay for the services to the hospital, and subsequently submit the claim to the TPA reimbursement. The valid claim will be processed and reimbursed as per Terms and Conditions of the Policy.
